Install Trim Set:

- 1. Cut out an access hole in the wall lining for the mixer, 52-75mm as per drawing and fix lining in place.
- 2. To secure the faceplate to the wall, remove the protective tape from the seal and slide the faceplate over the mixer body and position against the wall lining.
 - a. Ensure seal is in place on the inside of plate for valve body.
 - b. Gap in seal is at the bottom with H on the left and C on the right.
 - c. Sealant will be required behind faceplate on uneven surfaces for water seal.
- 3. Install the handle onto the cartridge lever and tighten the grub screw and fit button





- Greens FloBOOST® shower mixer is a Venturi mixer using the cold water pressure to maximise the hot water flow and is factory set for UNEQUAL PRESSURE.
 - a. Mains Cold goes through the boost jet at mixer outlet.

CHECK FIRST: Do you have EQUAL or UNEQUAL pressure at the mixer?

- EQUAL LOW PRESURE: The FloBOOST® valve will perform best if can link a
 mains pressure cold feed to the cold inlet of the valve.
- EQUAL PRESSURE (LOW & MAINS): The **JET MUST BE REMOVED.**
 - a. Anti-clockwise with a 10mm socket.
 - b. Ensure the ENTIRE JET IS REMOVED.
- UNEQUAL PRESSURE: Mixer is set up for unequal pressure.
- COLD WATER PRESSURE: If **over 500Kpa** a limiting vale **must** be installed as this will effect the mixing operation.
- HOT TEMPERATURE: Must be **minimum** 55°C at the mixer.
- RAIL SHOWERS: Wide bore hose 10mm with a good single function handset for low pressure, with no restrictors. Greens RainBoost® shower range is recommended.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Installing Valve Body:

- 1. Position the mixer against a mounting board within the maximum and minimum depth allowed and fix.
 - a. 28-65m behind finished wall surface.
 - b. Hot (H) enters on the left and cold (C) enters on the right.
 - c. Outlet to the top.

2. UNEQUAL PRESSURE:

- a. Install minimum 150mm of STRAIGHT PIPE from the mixer outlet.
- b. <u>CHECK</u>: THE JET must FIT INSIDE the swivel nut connector.
 - i. If it doesn't, an M & F SOCKET must be installed to mixer outlet.
 - ii. This is to ensure the jet is not damaged and the mixer performance is not compromised.

3. <u>EQUAL PRESSURE</u>:

- a. REMOVE JET from the mixer outlet anti-clockwise with a **10mm socket**
- 4. Connect water supply to the male hot & cold inlets and to the shower outlet. Do not pressure test with valve in the open position when outlet is closed.

Turn on water supply to the mixer and check for leaks.
