



Ceramic Cartridge Adjustment

Do not remove the ceramic cartridge from the body assembly while carrying out the following adjustments. *Note: the cartridge is factory set for maximum temperature*

Remove half-dome (if attached)



Mix temperature limit

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Operating Pressure:

Min 150 kPa, Max 1000 kPa.

Recommended 150 kPa - 500 kPa.

Install a pressure limiting valve if supply exceeds 1000kPa.

Operating Temperature:

Hot: Max 80°C.


Cold: Min 5°C .

Inlet Connections:

All 1/2" BSP.

IMPORTANT



Please read all of the instructions before installation

Avoid restrictive piping, fittings or sharp angled bends when plumbing the mixer.

Do not hydrostatic test the installation with this mixer installed. Damage to the ceramic headworks may occur.

All pipe-work must be thoroughly flushed prior to installation of the mixer. In-line filters must be installed on both hot and cold supplies to prevent foreign particles damaging the ceramic headworks.

NOTE: It is the responsibility of the installer to ensure a water proof seal is achieved between the faceplate and finished surface of the wall. If in any doubt about the quality of the seal the faceplate should be removed and then reinstalled using silicon to ensure a seal is achieved.



Final fit-off (number 5 & 6)

- Trim 1/2" BSP tube to length. Max 15mm +/- 2mm protruding from wall lining. 26mm from front of Inlet connector to wall lining.
- Fit face plate to wall (use sealant).
- Fit Inlet Connector and spout. *Note: Do not turn spout against face plate to avoid marking.* Tighten with Allen Key.
- Assemble 'O' ring, half dome and handle.
