# **SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS**

To ensure the optimum performance and customer satisfaction please adhere to the following:

- Flush out all pipe work prior to installation.
- Maximum hot water temperature is 60°C. If the water temperature exceeds 60°C an approved tempering valve must be fitted
- Installation should comply with relevant local authority requirements.
- In accordance with good plumbing practice, filters should be fitted to supply lines to eliminate damage to the ceramic cartridge from suspended solids.
- AS/NZS 3500.1 states that pressures above 500kPa can cause damage from water hammer, reduce the life of appliances, taps & fittings, cause excessive noise in the system and recommend that a pressure limiting valve (PLV) be fitted.


# **UNEQUAL PRESSURE**

1. OUTLET:

Remove aerator from mixer and replace with flow straightener.

2. INLET

Fit COLD supply hose end with male female brass nipple with flow restrictor prefitted in the orientation shown.

### **HOW TO INSTALL**

- 1. Cut a mounting hole 32mm in diameter. There must be a minimum 15mm width of flat around the hole.
- 2. Fit flange to base of faucet.
- 3. Screw the two stud fixings into mixer base.
- 4. Screw the "HOT" supply hose (with RED marking) into hole of mixer base (with RED marking).
- 5. Screw the "COLD" supply hose into the remaining hole of mixer base.
- 6. Lower the fitted supply hoses, one hose at a time, into mounting hole.
- 7. From UNDERNEATH the bench, fit the rubber horseshoe washer (if supplied), and metal horse shoe washer around both hoses and over the threaded studs.
- 8. Screw on the M6 nut and tighten with your fingers.
- 9. Check that the mixer and flange are correctly aligned on the bench. Secure with a spanner.
- 10. Flush the supply pipes to remove debris.
- 11. Turn on water supply and check for leaks.

Maximum bend for flexible hose is 35mm radius. The nipples on the hoses must be connected to fittings which have machined end faces, not "sawn off" threaded tube.

- 2) This warranty is for the lifetime of the first registered owner of the residential dwelling in which the Mixer is installed and who completes this warranty card and is not transferable to any subsequent owner of the dwelling (subject to paragraph 5 under 'What Lifetime Extension Warranty does not cover).
